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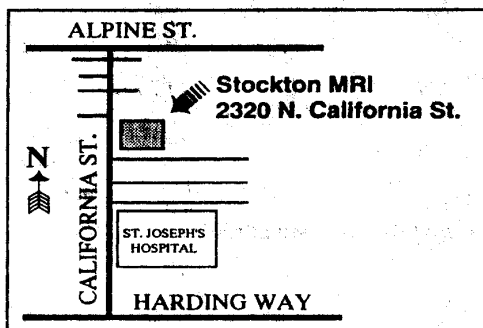

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Thank you for choosing Stockton MRI & Molecular Imaging Medical Center. Our highly-trained, experienced and courteous professional staff will use the most advanced imaging equipment to perform the appropriate examination requested for you.

Please inform us of any medical conditions and allergies that you may have so we can better serve you. Please inform us if you are pregnant. Please inform us as soon as possible if you are unable to be present for your scheduled appointment. For certain examinations, special medications will have been ordered specifically for you.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Please follow the instructions below for your particular examination:

### MRI

Your examination will be explained to you before being done. Please do not bring jewelry or valuables with you.

For abdomen and pelvic exams, please do not eat within 4 hours prior to your MRI. Continue to take your medications as you routinely do.

### CT

Head, chest, abdomen, and pelvis exams are generally done with intravenous contrast. You will be informed if you need to go to a lab to get a blood test done prior to your CT. Please do not eat within 4 hours prior to your exam. If no contrast is to be used, then no preparation is required. Continue to take your medications as you routinely do.

### PET-CT

Do not eat within the 6 hours prior to your examination. You may drink only water. Continue to take your medications as you routinely do. Avoid heavy exercising 24-hours prior to your examination. You will be contacted with further instructions to help obtain optimum results, including a one day low-carbohydrate diet.

### NUCLEAR MEDICINE

Please follow closely the specific instructions that you will receive at the time of scheduling, which will be based on your particular exam. Some examinations may require you to not eat or temporarily stop taking some medications.

### ULTRASOUND

**For pregnant patients (13 weeks or less):** Drink 16 oz of water 1 hour prior to your appointment. Hold your bladder (do not urinate) prior to your appointment.

**For pelvic exams:** Drink 16 oz of water prior to your examination. The examination cannot be done while you are menstruating, but can be scheduled at least 7 days after your last cycle.

**For abdominal exams:** Do not eat or drink for 8 hours prior to your examination.

### X-RAY / FLUOROSCOPY

Please follow the instructions that you will receive at the time of scheduling. The instructions will be based on your particular examination. Continue to take your medications as you routinely do.

**For Barium Enemas:** Please report to our office at least 2 days prior to your examination.

**For Upper GI and Small Bowel examinations:** You may have only a light evening meal (broth, jello, toast, etc.) with NO dairy products the night before your examination. Do not eat, chew gum, or smoke after midnight until your exam is completed.
